Congratulations on taking the next step toward a Michigan degree! To receive full consideration for admission, please submit all required documents and complete and sign your application.

- **HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS:** Request official high school transcripts with ACT or SAT scores to be sent directly to UM-Dearborn from your high school. Your high school counselor can assist you in the process. In addition, request transcripts from any college or university you have attended while in high school. (visit [www.umd.umich.edu/apply](http://www.umd.umich.edu/apply))
- **TRANSFER STUDENTS:** Request official transcripts from all colleges and universities you have attended to be sent directly to UM-Dearborn. Students with fewer than 24 transferable credits will also need to request that an official high school transcript with ACT or SAT scores be sent directly to UM-Dearborn. - Include payment for the \$30 non-refundable application fee (check or money order)

## SCHOLARSHIPS

By submitting an application, you are automatically considered for scholarships offered through UM-Dearborn.

- **HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS:** To receive full consideration for 2010 merit scholarships, you must complete and submit an application for admission by December 15, 2009. We strongly recommend that all required documentation (transcripts and test scores) be submitted by December 15 for scholarship consideration. - **TRANSFER STUDENTS:** Students eligible for transfer scholarships will automatically be notified by the Office of Admissions and Orientation shortly after admission. (visit [www.umd.umich.edu/trscholar](http://www.umd.umich.edu/trscholar))

## FINANCIAL AID

For all eligible financial aid programs, you should submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by February 14, 2010 (**UM-Dearborn code: 002326**).

Financial aid award notifications begin in mid-March and continue on a rolling basis.

Winter term applicants: submit the FAFSA by November 1. (visit [www.umd.umich.edu/financialaid](http://www.umd.umich.edu/financialaid))

## TESTS

**ACT or SAT** is required for admission for incoming freshmen. Only one standardized test score is required. One is NOT preferred over the other. Both tests will be reviewed. If a student retakes a test, the best overall test score is used in the admission process.

**TOEFL, MELAB, APIEL, or IELTS** may be required for non-native speakers of English.

**Advanced Placement Tests:** Credit is granted for scores of 3 or above on most AP exams. Please request to have the College Board send your scores to UM-Dearborn. (visit [www.collegeboard.com/student/testing/ap/about.html](http://www.collegeboard.com/student/testing/ap/about.html))
